The Midlands Prison Portlaoise

After a recent visit to the Midlands Prison, I am delighted that we have re-established our link with them and look forward to offering support and help as it is needed. To begin the process a grant has been obtained from our AFIA Reimagined fund. This has been used to buy stationery and craft products for the children's area of the Visitor's Centre, as well as providing release kits for the prisoners, including a gym bag and basic toiletries. We hope in the future to also provide vouchers for McDonalds and Supermac's.

I would hope that branches will become involved in this project and perhaps could help us supply selection boxes for Santa's visit to the Visitor's Centre in December. The ones suggested by staff are the '3 for €5' size (with no nut products) so preferably the ones made by Cadbury. If any branch or member would like to help out with this then please bring them along to **Autumn Council**, where we will have a drop-off box available.

As this is a renewed link, we thought perhaps we should also have a **new name** for the project – so, if anyone has any suggestions, please send them to me.
