The following week (21st) two services were held to remember Annabella:

- The first was in St. Fintan's Cemetery in Sutton where a rededication of Annabella's grave took place following extensive restoration, which was funded by the National Heritage Council.
- The second was a commemoration service held in All Saint's Church, Raheny, where Annabella worshiped for many years.

Both of these services were attended by The Most Revd. Dr. Michael Jackson, Archbishop of Dublin and Glendalough, and the Deputy Major of Fingal, Daniel Whooley.


It is hoped that all members will purchase a copy (and sell a few within their community too) so as your branches begin to re-open please let me know how many you will need.
